WHAT DOES PARKSIDE ADVISORS LLC (“PARKSIDE”) DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

WHY?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
WHAT?	<p>The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Social security number ▪ Income ▪ Assets ▪ Checking account information ▪ Account balances and account transactions <p>When you are <i>no longer</i> our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.</p>
HOW?	All financial companies need to share customers’ personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers’ personal information, the reasons Parkside chooses to share and whether you can limit this sharing.

Reasons we can share your personal information	Does Parkside Share?	Can you limit this sharing?
For our everyday business purposes - such as to process your transactions, maintain your account(s), do financial planning or respond to court orders and legal investigations	Yes	No

<p>How does Parkside protect my personal information?</p>	<p>To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.</p> <p>Employees and service providers sign a confidentiality agreement that prohibits unauthorized disclosure or use of personal information.</p> <p>We shred discarded paper records.</p>
<p>How does Parkside collect my personal information?</p>	<p>We collect your personal information, for example, when you</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Tell us about your investment or retirement portfolio ▪ Enter into an investment advisory contract ▪ Seek financial or tax advice ▪ Open an account ▪ Give us your income information
<p>Why can't I limit all sharing?</p>	<p>Federal law gives you the right to limit only</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes—information about your creditworthiness ▪ affiliates from using your information to market to you ▪ sharing for non-affiliates to market to you <p>State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.</p>
Definitions	
<p>Affiliates</p>	<p>Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ <i>Parkside has no affiliates.</i>
<p>Non-affiliates</p>	<p>Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ <i>Parkside does not share with non-affiliates so they can market to you.</i>
<p>Joint Marketing</p>	<p>A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ <i>Parkside does not jointly market.</i>
